FAFSA Process:

 Parent and student each create FSA ID (3-5 days to process):



2. Student completes the FAFSA and invites contributors (parents). List up to 20 schools that you have applied to:



3. Contributors complete and submit their part of the FAFSA within 45 days of the student submitting. FAFSA is incomplete until the contributor submits.

- 4. In a few days you will receive your student aid report (SAR) by email. This will include your Pell Grant eligibility and list your Student Aid Index (SAI).
- If you have been accepted to a college you listed on your FAFSA you will receive a financial aid offer letter including grants, scholarships, work study and/or loans (March/April).
- 6. You may be automatically considered for some grants and receive email notifications if you are eligible. Follow up submissions may be required.
- 7. Accept awards! You accept your financial aid package through the school you choose. You accept MD state awards in your MDCAPS account.
