In support of our students' successful transition to 9<sup>th</sup> Grade, we invite students to participate in a **Virtual Early Entry Day** program. On **Friday, September 4<sup>th</sup>**, Owings Mills High School will host orientation for students entering Grade 9 for the 2020–2021 school year.

Students will use the Google Meets link below to access the Grade 9 Meeting. For each class period, students should access their courses in Schoology to find each Google Meets code from their teachers; the same way that they logged into classes in middle school. Students will have a chance to log-in to each class, see and meet their teachers as well as classmates, and practice navigating Schoology and Google Meets; the platforms that we will continue to use as the school year opens. The schedule for September 4<sup>th</sup> is as follows:

Our Virtual Early Entry Day is a student event and will not replace Virtual Back to School Night; a student/parent orientation activity, which will take place the night before on September 3<sup>rd</sup>.

It is a good idea prior to September 4<sup>th</sup> to log onto Schoology to check your child's schedule and make sure that they are able to use their BCPS credentials successfully. Don't forget that prior to starting school, students will need to update their devices; directions to perform these updates are included as an attachment in this email.

We are looking forward to welcoming our new 9<sup>th</sup> Grade students on Friday, September 4<sup>th</sup> and while not required, we hope your child will take advantage of this opportunity. The first regular day of school for all students is Tuesday, September 8, 2020. Due to the shortened week, Wednesday, September 9<sup>th</sup> will be an instructional day; students should follow the Daily Instructional Schedule.
